

VELCADE Reimbursement Assistance Program (VRAP)

Our goal is simple: We want to help you get treatment with VELCADE® (bortezomib), regardless of your insurance or financial situation.

There are many resources available to help you navigate the sometimes complex world of healthcare. This section provides information on the reimbursement and patient assistance program resources available to you under the VRAP umbrella of services.

VELCADE Reimbursement Assistance Program

VRAP helps both you and your care providers navigate the reimbursement process. When you call VRAP, you can speak with a live Reimbursement Case Manager about insurance or coverage questions you may have.

The VRAP hotline accepts calls from patients, caregivers, physicians, and other healthcare professionals. Information can be mailed or faxed to you, your caregiver, or your physician.

The VRAP provides the following services to both you and your doctor's office:

- ▼ Insurance verification
- ▼ Claim appeals support*
- ▼ Identification of alternate and supplemental insurance coverage options
- ▼ Co-payment foundation support information
- ▼ Screening and enrollment of eligible patients into the Patient Assistance Program
- ▼ Transportation assistance

VELCADE Patient Assistance Program (PAP)

If you have no insurance coverage for VELCADE® (bortezomib), you may be eligible to participate in the PAP. If you qualify for the program, VELCADE will be delivered to your treating physician at no cost.

If you have insurance coverage but have been denied coverage for VELCADE, please contact a Reimbursement Case Manager at the VRAP hotline to inquire about potential product replacement.

Enrollment Process

- ▼ If you do not have insurance coverage for VELCADE, you must apply for assistance through your healthcare professional. To demonstrate eligibility, you must complete an enrollment form and provide income documentation as well as health insurance information
- ▼ It is strongly recommended that your doctor's office enroll patients into the PAP prior to the start of treatment with VELCADE. All enrollment forms must be received within 6 months of the first treatment. Enrollment forms can be obtained by calling the VRAP hotline

Enrollment Assessment

- ▼ We will respond by telephone to any completed enrollment application within 2 business days. A follow-up letter explaining the determination will be sent to the healthcare professional
- ▼ A Reimbursement Case Manager will contact your doctor's office with respect to your qualification status

Enrollment Management

- ▼ One week prior to every cycle, a Reimbursement Case Manager will contact your doctor's office to confirm that you will continue to receive VELCADE and that your information remains unchanged
- ▼ You are eligible to participate in the PAP for 12 months if you remain qualified. If you are still receiving VELCADE after 12 months, you will need to re-enroll in the program

Eligibility

Eligibility for the PAP is based on consideration of several criteria, including such factors as:

- ▼ Household income
- ▼ Treatment setting
- ▼ US residency
- ▼ Information on your prescription
