Questions about multiple myeloma

Diagnosis:

- ✓ What is the typical outcome for people with my diagnosis?
- ✓ What are your thoughts on getting a second opinion?

Symptoms:

- ✓ What symptoms might show that my multiple myeloma is advancing?

Tests:

- ✓ What types of tests will I need and how often will I need them?
- ✓ Can you explain the results of my blood and urine tests?

Questions about initial treatment

Treatment:

- ✓ What are the treatment options available to me?
- ✓ Can you help me understand the differences in available treatments?
- ✓ How effective is the treatment you're recommending?
- ✓ How long will I receive treatment and how will it be given?
- ✓ What signs might show that my multiple myeloma is responding?
- ✓ What happens after I respond to treatment? What else should I expect from multiple myeloma and its treatment?
- ✓ What happens after I complete my treatment?
- ✓ What happens if/when my multiple myeloma comes back (relapse)?

Side effects:

- ✓ What side effects have been reported with this treatment?
- ✓ How can I prevent any side effects from treatment or my multiple myeloma?

Questions about retreatment

If your multiple myeloma has come back (relapsed) after previously achieving a benefit with VELCADE (bortezomib):

- ✓ I was treated for my multiple myeloma, so why did it come back?
- ✓ Why would retreatment work if the multiple myeloma came back after the first time I was treated?
- ✓ How long will retreatment last?
- ✓ How will retreatment be different from my first treatment?
- ✓ I had problems with side effects. Will they return?

Questions about subsequent treatment

If your multiple myeloma has come back (relapsed) but you are new to VELCADE:

- ✓ I was treated for my multiple myeloma, so why did it come back?
- ✓ Why would another treatment work if the first one didn't?
- ✓ Do I need to stay on treatment longer to keep the multiple myeloma from coming back?
- ✓ How will treatment be different this time?

Additional questions

- ✓ Can I still get treatment if I don't have insurance?
- ✓ Will I be able to work and take care of my family?
- ✓ Will I need home healthcare?
- ✓ Will my hair fall out?
- ✓ Will I be nauseous?
- ✓ Will I be exhausted?
- ✓ Can I eat all kinds of foods?
- ✓ Can I drink alcohol?
- ✓ Will the treatments affect my sex life?
